

Preparation Notice

Mt. Helix Pest & Termite Control has been contracted to provide pest control service to your home. Cabinets and drawers to be treated should be wiped down to provide our company with a clean surface to apply our products. We ask that you DO NOT clean/wipe up our product after we have treated areas for the product to maintain effectiveness. We also ask that you DO NOT use over-the-counter pest control products before or after any of the following services. The products we use will not work as well when used with over-the-counter products. Below is a list of common pests and the preparation for each service.

ANTS: It is not necessary to vacate for this service unless you have sensitivities to pesticides. Floor mats and other items will need to be removed from the floor for services. All items in the kitchen and bathroom cabinets need to be removed if Ants are in those areas. These items can be put back into the cabinets 3-4 hours after the treatment has been completed. Children and pets should be kept away from area being treated while the technician is performing treatment.

COCKROACHES: It is not necessary to vacate for this service unless you have sensitivities to pesticides. Floor mats and other items will need to be removed from the floor for services. The items on the kitchen counter will need to be removed for service. All items in the kitchen, bathroom cabinets & drawers need to be removed. These items can be put back into the cabinets 3-4 hours after the treatment has been completed-or as long as the technician has recommended. Children & pets should be kept away from area being treated while the technician is performing treatment.

FLEAS: Carpets should be frequently and thoroughly vacuumed by the occupant before and after the treatment. All occupants including pets must vacate the unit during the treatment and for a minimum of 3 hours after the treatment. Children and pets should be kept away from area being treated while the technician is performing treatment.

SPIDERS: Clutter should be reduced around the home so that the technician is able to treat the unit thoroughly. All occupants including pets must vacate the unit during the treatment and for at least 3 hours after treatment. Children and pets should be kept away from area being treated while the technician is performing treatment.

SILVERFISH: It is not necessary to vacate for this service unless you have sensitivities to pesticides. Floor mats and other items will need to be removed from the floor for services. At least one electric outlet in each room should be clear of plugs to allow our technician to treat in the outlet Children and pets should be kept away from area being treated while the technician is performing treatment.

Structural Pest Control Companies are regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board, and apply pesticides which are approved for use by California Department of Food and Agriculture and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the State finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risk if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends on the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized. If within 24 hours of application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to the flu like headache, dizziness, nausea, tearing, and coughing, nose and throat irritation or develop shortness of breath, double vision, unusual drowsiness and weakness, or tremors contact your physician or poison control center (see below) and your pest control operator immediately.
